To give the would-be conquerors something to worry about, a new 'Maline' weapon, I opened up with quick fire on the logs in the river using all twenty five rounds with my new "Make My Day" 03 MMD rifle that shut him up.

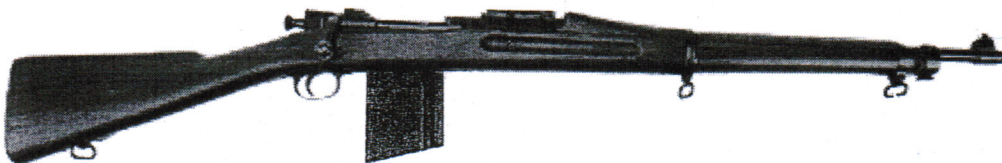
